May we live the Sacraments of your Church and worship you in the Eucharistic Sacrifice offered once and for all by Jesus Christ in the Upper Room and upon the Cross of Calvary. May the Sacraments of Faith deepen your life within us and among us, freeing us from the slavery of sin and uniting us to the Paschal Mystery of the Cross and Resurrection. May our every sorrow and pain be held in the wounded hands of Jesus Christ and made to work his redemption in us and in your Church. Deepen our Faith, strengthen our hope, and intensify our love, united with you, the One true God.

Heal and renew the bonds of marriage. Restore the love of husband and wife, parent and child. Heal the wounds of neglect, cast out fear, and soften hearts hardened through years of disappointment. Where abuse has stolen innocence create new hope. Teach us to hold all human life sacred. Give us hearts to love you in our neighbor, eyes to see you in human suffering, and ears to hear the cry of your poor. May the immigrant and refugee be welcomed as Christ. May your Spirit rest upon our parish church, that we might be a light for Christ in these hard times. Because you have loved us first, make us generous in love for one another.

Where we have done so, draw us back to you by your power to make all things new. Guard us from the lure of passing wealth or fame. In doubt or stormy darkness, disappointment or grief, lift us by your outstretched hand and make us firm. Keep our eyes always fixed on Jesus Christ, and him crucified. Through the courage born of the one and holy faith, may we always have an answer for the hope that is ours in Christ and in his Church.

May we listen for the Spirit praying from within our hearts, that Spirit adopting us each as your own beloved child in Christ. May we join the Hosts of Heaven and the Communion of all your Saints in prayer and adoration before you, Abba, most Holy. May the song of the new Jerusalem raise us up through all the voices contrary to your own. With our Blessed Lady, Mary our Mother, may we always and everywhere magnify your most holy name, in that eternal unity of your Holy Spirit, ever through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Stewardship: May 23, 2010 Pentecost Sunday**

It has been seven weeks and one day since Easter Sunday. It is Pentecost [from the Greek word for “fiftieth”], the day on which the Holy Spirit encourages the Apostles to proclaim Jesus Christ to people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. Each person heard the Apostles in their own tongue. Amazing! Even more amazing is that people with a variety of religious beliefs came to believe in Jesus. Later Paul writes to Christians in Corinth, a seaport city with people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. He tells them something so obvious we often forget it: Each of us is a person with a unique array of talents, abilities and gifts that God has given to us to use for ourselves and for others. Material wealth, intelligence, artistic talent, athletic ability, the gift of music, and many others - God intends for us to enjoy them ourselves and to share them with others. How are we doing with that? One day God will ask.
