

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS IN DAVIESS & MCLEAN COUNTIES, KENTUCKY
1849-PRESENT/ *indicates closure at site

Owensboro Catholic High School

- 1849-1889 St. Frances, Owensboro, Known as an Academy taught by Sisters of Charity
1889-1948 moved to 5th and Allen Street
1948-1950 High School consolidated with St. Joseph, Owensboro
1950- Assumption High School better known as Owensboro Catholic High School

Brescia University

- 1863-1870 Saint Joseph Academy, St. Joseph, KY, taught by Sisters of Loretta
1874-1983 Mount Saint Joseph Academy, Maple Mount, KY, taught by Ursuline Sisters
1925-1950 Mount Saint Joseph Junior College, Maple Mount, KY, taught by Ursuline Sisters
1950 Mount Saint Joseph Junior College Freshman class moved to Owensboro and named Brescia College
1950-1998 Brescia College taught by Ursuline Sisters of Mount St. Joseph with other lay and religious staff
1998- Brescia University

Saints Joseph & Paul Grade School*

- 1870-1924 St. Hubertus, later St. Joseph. Several locations. Taught by Louisville Ursulines until 1919 then MSJ Ursulines
1924-1948 St. Joseph High School.
1948-1950 High School joined St. Frances.
1948-1977 Saints Joseph & Paul Grade School. Site closed with consolidation to St. Stephen Cathedral School.

Saint Stephen Cathedral School*

- 1879-1914 St. Stephen's Boys School (St. Frances, the girls' school)
1914-1939 Boys and Girls at St. Frances Academy
1939-1948 Catholic Grade School (grades one -five), "Our Blessed Mother" at 7th and Frederica Street (Old "K of C" building); grades six-eight continued at St. Frances.
1948-1962 Renamed St. Stephen School at 7th and Frederica Street
1962 Moved to new building on Locust Street
1978-1989 Renamed Cathedral School
1989- Cathedral Pre-School continues at site

Saint Lawrence Parish School*

- 1833 Fr. John Wathen, first resident pastor, taught Catholic children in a school setting part-time

- 1880-1889 St. Lawrence Church– St. Joseph School, taught by Franciscans
 1889-1910 Taught by lay teachers
 1920-1961 Taught by Ursulines of Mount St. Joseph. School burned in 1960
 1960 Students commuted to St. William's, Knottsville

Saint Mary Grade School & Holy Trinity High School

- 1886-1918 St. Mary of the Woods School, Whitesville
 1918-1954 New building erected (1918), Grade and High School
 1967- New building for Trinity High School. Mary Carrico High School consolidated, Ursuline Sisters joined the staff.

Saint Raphael Parish School*

- 1900-1903 St. Raphael School, West Louisville
 1924-1963 reopened for a time

Saint Alphonsus Parish School*

- 1862 Fr. Ivo Schacht opened a 20 X 50 ft. log schoolhouse staffed by two lay teachers. It lasted for one year.
 1863-1870 Sisters of Loretto from Marion County, KY, conducted a boarding and day school (St. Joseph Academy). The building was destroyed by fire in 1870. See thereafter Mt. St. Joseph Academy with the Ursuline Sisters.
 1901-1905 St. Alphonsus School, St. Joseph, KY
 1913-1985 reopened for a time

Saint Elizabeth Parish School*

- 1911-1973 St. Elizabeth School, Curdsville

Saint Peter Parish School*

- 1910-1984 St. Peter School, Stanley

Saint William/Mary Carrico School

- 1912-1937 Saint William School, Knottsville
 1937-1967 High School established, later consolidated with Holy Trinity, Whitesville
 1950-1963 Four room addition to school
 1963- Name changed to Mary Carrico Elementary School

Saint Charles Parish School*

- 1919-1925 St. Charles School, Livermore

Saint Anthony Parish School*

- 1912-1966 St. Anthony School, Browns Valley

Saint Martin Parish School*

1916-1981 St. Martin School, Rome

Saint Mary Magdalene/Holy Angels School*

1918-1922 Taught by lay teachers first five years
1923 Ursuline Sisters begin teaching at the school
1989-1997 Consolidated and renamed Holy Angels School
1997-2004 Moved to the old Sorgho Public School building until closed

Blessed Sacrament Chapel School*

1940-1959 Blessed Sacrament Chapel School

Blessed Mother Parish/Angela Merici/OCS 4-6

1948-1989 Blessed Mother School
1989-2004 Angela Merici School
2004- Owensboro Catholic Elementary 4-6 Campus

Saint Sebastian Parish School*

1952-1967 St. Sebastian, Calhoun
1987- St. Sebastian Pre-School

Immaculate Parish School/OCS Middle School

1954-1989 Immaculate School
1989- Owensboro Catholic Middle School

Saint Pius X Parish School/Bishop Francis R. Cotton School*

1958-1989 St. Pius X School
1989-2004 Bishop Francis R. Cotton School
1971-2004 Kindergarten & Day Care
1971- Day Care & Pre-School (Continuing)

Our Lady of Lourdes Parish School/Catherine Spaulding/OCS K-3

1959-1989 Our Lady of Lourdes School
1989-2004 Catherine Spaulding
2004- Owensboro Catholic Elementary 4-6 Campus

Precious Blood Parish School/Bishop Henry J. Soenneker School*

1960-1989 Precious Blood School
1989-2001 Bishop Henry J. Soenneker School
2007- Day Care & Pre-School (Continuing)

Saint Augustine Parish School, Reed, Henderson County*

1922-1964 Staffed by the Dominican Nuns of St. Catharine, Ky.
