St. Pius X Parish Council met on April 10, 2017, at 6 p.m.

### **REPORTS**

**Families in Faith:** The Parish Council discussed the upcoming New Evangelization Summit. A major goal of this event is to reach out to people who have left the Catholic Church. Initiative 3 of the Long-Range Plan is about this subject, so it is fitting that St. Pius X is hosting a live video feed of this Summit. It occurs on the weekend of May 12-13. On Friday night and Saturday, the Parish has rented space in the Logsdon Center to show the live feed. Parishioners can attend for \$15 each, while non-parishioners can attend for \$35 each. The Parish has set a goal of 50 parishioners and 50 non-parishioners.

**OCS Education Report:** No report was provided.

**Financial Report:** John McCarty reported the summary of Income, Expenses, and Assets as of February 2017 as reviewed by the Finance Committee. February was a good financial month for the Parish as it included revenue from the Mardi Gras fund raiser. Recently, the Daycare made several improvements to its process of collecting past-due accounts and keeping accounts from becoming past-due.

**Business Manager Report:** Michelle Roberts reported that the process of upgrading all office PC's to Windows 10 has begun and is going well. Ten additional folding tables have been purchased for use at Parish events. Additional folding chairs will be purchased soon.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Picnic Updates:** Preparations for the Picnic are progressing. The Picnic Committee has decided to move the quantity of meats to order has been finalized. Raffle items – including two quilts – are being accumulated. As of this meeting date, almost \$1,800 of Picnic raffle tickets have been sold. The zero-turn mower that will be given away at the Picnic has been purchased. The Parish is currently printing raffle tickets for it, and will begin selling them after they're printed. The Committee continues to look for new ways to advertise the picnic.

**Ten Commandments Sign for the Parish:** The Knights of Columbus Council 817 is continuing to work on designing the Ten Commandments sign that will be donated to the Parish. This sign will be displayed prominently outdoors at the church. They hope to finalize its design in the next month.

### **PASTOR REPORT**

**Long Range Plan:** The Parish Council reviewed the March 31, 2017 Committee Status Report. All Committees are progressing toward their action goals, and are all on schedule. The expenditure statement provided an excellent synopsis of each Initiative Committee's current and projected future financial needs.
